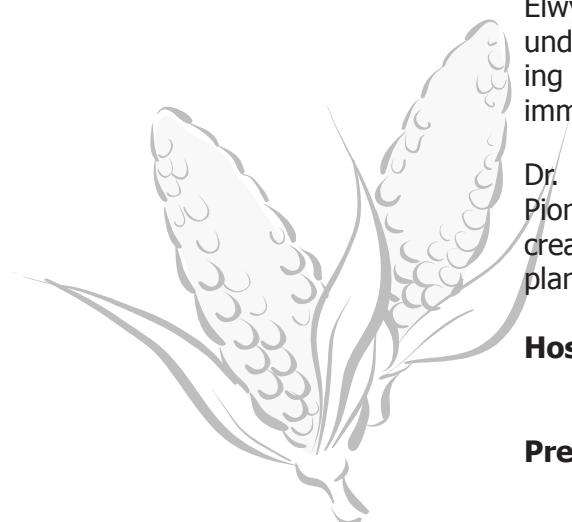


CROP WEATHER OUTLOOK 2010
